

Informusic Privacy Policy

It is important to Informusic LLC that visitors to our Site and users of our Application understand what information we gather about them, how we use it, and how we work to protect it. By using our Site, our Application and/or signing up for services such as membership, you consent to information practices outlined in our Terms of Use and Privacy Policy.

Information Collection

Informusic requests personally identifiable information when you register for an account. Information may be used or requested to perform research, improve usability of the site, administer mailing lists or online communities, or other activities related to the Application and the Site. This information may include, but is not limited to, personal names, e-mail addresses, location, organization and date of birth.

Available log records, account information, and all data stored on our servers may be accessed by our system administrators. In the event that we are required by law (including a court order) to disclose the information you submit, we will provide you with notice (unless we are prohibited) that a request for your information has been made so that you may object to the disclosure. We will send this notice by email to the address you have given us. We will not release your name, email address or any other personal information to anyone outside Informusic without your consent, unless we are under a legal order to do so, or there is an emergency involving danger to a person or property.

Remember that any information you share in public areas, such as the Informusic comments area, becomes public and therefore this Privacy Policy does not apply to any information you choose to make public. We encourage visitors to Informusic to be cautious about what they disclose and that they do not post any personal information that they expect to keep private. Personally identifiable information is information that can be used to contact you or determine your specific identity ("Personally Identifiable Information"). If other information is linked to this information, it also becomes Personally Identifiable Information.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that the Site can send to your browser for storage on your computer's hard drive. They make your use of the Site easier by saving your status and preferences and are refreshed every time you visit. We may use session cookies when you visit our website while your browser is open, or while you are logged into the Site. To facilitate our registration and login functions, we may use cookies to recognize when you return to the Site. If you do not logout of your account, these cookies allow us to keep track of your username and password so that you do not have to resubmit the information to log into your account. If others will be using your computer, you should log out of your account so that your logon information is cleared. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies, but you may

be able to change the settings to refuse cookies or to be alerted when cookies are being sent. When you call up our site on your computer, our servers enter the IP address of that computer into a log. To maintain our users' anonymity, we do not associate IP addresses with records containing Personally Identifiable Information.

Security

Informusic employs a number of security methods designed to prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure correct use of information. Your personal data will be stored within a database that is located behind a firewall for added security.

No data transmission over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be secure. As a result, while we try to protect your Personally Identifiable Information, we cannot ensure or guarantee the security of any information you transmit to us, and you do so at your own risk. We are not liable for the illegal acts of any third party.

Children's Privacy

The Site's content is intended for adults and we will not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 years of age. If you are a parent or legal guardian of a child under age 13 who you believe has submitted personal information to the Site, please contact us immediately.

Posting

Posting or updating content on the Site is a public action, and all content may be publicly visible. Identification of all contributed content may include, but is not limited to, display of your account name or IP address. All content may be retained for restorative, archival, or research purposes by Informusic. Editing or deleting content may alter the displayed state of the content, but will not permanently delete the content from the Site.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

Informusic may change its privacy policy from time to time. If we make any changes regarding disclosure of Personally Identifiable Information to third parties, we will post notice of the new policy on our home page.
